Washington DC COVID Emergency Response Grant

LIIF's Washington DC COVID Emergency Response Grant, in collaboration with the DC Family Child Care Association, supports licensed Child Development Home programs in Washington, D.C. who are experiencing financial hardship due to COVID-19.

Key Features

- Funding intends to cover gaps in revenue that would normally be received from tuition paid by “private-pay” families.
- If awarded, you may use funds to cover operating expenses such as **retention of staff**, rent/mortgage bills, taxes, insurance, utilities and any other expense related to typical operations for your program.

Applicants Must:

- Be licensed to operate a Child Development Home (CDH) or Expanded Child Development Home (CDX) in the District of Columbia by the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE);
- Show evidence the program has suffered a financial loss due to COVID-19; and
- Submit an application before June 5, 2020 to be considered in this initial round of funding. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis after June 5, subject to availability of additional funding.
